## 1. Status of Prop 84 Rounds 2&4

Approved extension until end of 2024 for outstanding Prop 84 grants.

Jennifer Krebs reported there are no new updates on AQPI following June report out.

# 2. Status of Prop 1 Implementation Funding

James Muller provided general overview for Prop 1 Round 1. 6 projects funded for \$22.5 million. For these projects, updates include:

- Engineer certificate of completion is in progress for Lower Walnut Creek
- \$3.6 million in invoices are being processed
- \$7.5 million submitted in the latest quarterly report submittal to DWR
- \$12.5 million in matching funds billed for the 6 projects

James Muller provided an update on Prop 1, Round 2 administration challenges posed by recent direction from DWR, which indicates indirect costs are no longer billable as part of grant reimbursement requests. This amounts to approximately \$440k of the Prop 1, Round 2 grant application's \$1.3 million in administration. Options to address this challenge include 1) a single agency supplying additional administration support funding; or 2) multiple agencies providing additional administration support funding.

**UPDATE:** This issue appears to be resolved with San Mateo RCD stepping up to support administrative funding needs for the region.

#### 3. Equity in IRWM

The Chair/Vice Chair did not have any updates.

# 4. Status of Prop 1 IRWM DACTIP

James Muller reported out that the DACTIP grant ends on June 30, 2023. A 90-day grace period exists to close things out. All partners have been paid. Two related reports are in process: 1) Grant Completion Report; and 2) TAP Water Quality Testing Report (Aug 2023 expected completion). James also provided an update on previous supporting staff no longer working on DACTIP.

#### 5. Announcements and Next Steps

## Announcements:

- EPA Water Quality Improvement Fund RFA is due 8/30/23 (updated deadline). \$30 million available.

- SFEP will work on bi-partisan infrastructure planning with \$900k/year available for climate adaptation and equity.
- SFEP is adding staff to support grant writing with communities and tribes.
- SB 867 and AB 1567 may include funding for IRWM up for \$300 million to \$500 million.

#### Action Items:

- 1) San Mateo RCD to execute agreement with SFEP to support administration of Prop 1, Round 2.
- 2) Coordinating Committee to discuss functional area representation at next meeting, including beginning an effort to fill any vacancies.
